Your Time	Flexible – collection of donated goods would always be on weekdays. Delivery/collection of the Wadars stand to/from fundraising events will usually be on a weekend.
What will you be doing?	<p>Wadars is fortunate enough to receive lots of donations of food and other items from members of the local community. In some cases the donors are not able to deliver the goods to our site, and so we rely on volunteers to collect them for us.</p> <p>There are two strands to this role. You could be helping with the collection and delivery of donated goods. This could include animal feed, toys, blankets, newspapers, and other items such as rabbit hutches or dog crates. This would generally be on week days.</p> <p>On some weekends Wadars has a stall at local fundraising events. We need a volunteer to drive our van to and from the event to drop off/collect our equipment and merchandise. This would usually be first thing in the morning and again later in the day.</p>
