



## Thinking of adopting a Wadars rabbit?

All Wadars rabbits are given a health check before being rehomed, and come to you with four weeks' free pet insurance, will be microchipped, and also vaccinated against Myxomatosis and Viral Haemorrhagic Disease. New owners are expected to maintain regular booster vaccinations.

Our rabbits are fostered in private homes and we will need to make an appointment for you to view them. Please telephone Wadars on **01903 247111** between 10am and 3pm, Monday to Friday for details. Once you have chosen a rabbit you will need to call us back to arrange a home check.

Before the home check you will need to have a fully weather-proofed hutch and run in place. The purpose of the home check is to discuss rabbit ownership with you and the health and welfare of the animal, as well as the housing you are providing for them. Once the home check has been approved, you will be able to arrange to collect your new rabbit. Please make sure that you have a suitable plastic or metal carrier for transporting your pet.

## Your accommodation

If you live in rented accommodation, Wadars will need written landlord consent agreeing to the adoption. This will need to be in place before a home check is arranged. We can email you the landlord consent form, or if you tell us your landlord's email address we can send it straight to them.

## **Financial Implications**

There is an adoption fee for all Wadars animals - for rabbits this is £30. The adoption fee is payable at the time of signing the adoption paperwork.

A large part of owning any animal is ensuring that all their needs are met. This includes veterinary treatment including regular vaccinations, as well as food and housing. Please ensure that you have considered the full financial cost of owning a rabbit before you begin the process to adopt an animal from Wadars.

The minimum age for adopting an animal from Wadars is 18 years.
