



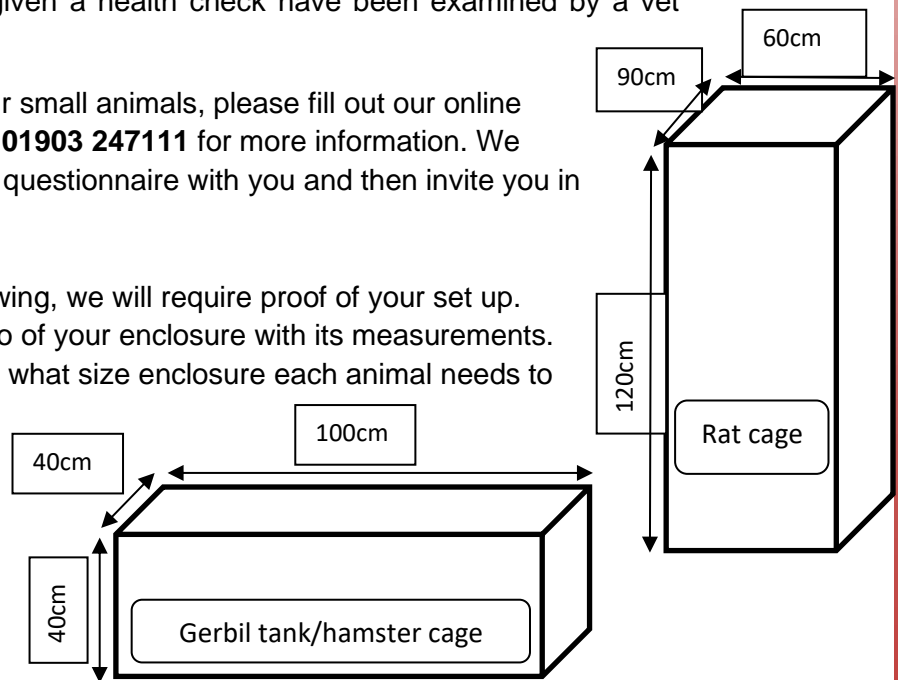
THINKING OF ADOPTING A SMALL MAMMAL?

Although they may be small, owning a small mammal may require more work than originally expected but if you ensure to meet all their welfare requirements, they can make fantastic pets. It is advised you do some research on your chosen animal; this could include their diets, grooming, cleaning, and social needs, as a rat can differ from a hamster. Or give us a call and we can discuss the differences and needs before you commit to adopting a new pet.

Before we invite you in for a viewing, we will require proof of your set up. This would likely be a short video of your enclosure with its measurements. See the diagrams to get an idea of the approximate space small mammals require.



Your accommodation

If you live in rented accommodation, Wadars will need written landlord consent agreeing to the adoption. This will need to be in place before a home check or viewing can be arranged. Please provide your landlords contact details on your application so we can gain this consent.

Financial Implications

There is an adoption fee for all Wadars animals - for rats this is £10 each, for other animals please contact us for fee information. This fee helps to cover the cost of their care with us. Ensure that you have considered the full financial cost of owning a small mammal, such as accommodation, bedding, food and vet checks, before you begin the process to adopt an animal from Wadars.

The minimum age for adopting an animal from Wadars is 18 years.
